


**FRWS 6910: FIELD BOTANY:

Learn common plant families and develop your skills in using scientific guides. More than one thousand species (approximately 5% of the flora of temperate North America) can be found within a few miles of the Teton Science Schools' Kelly campus. Sharp ecological gradients on the Teton slopes and surrounding ranges provide an ideal setting for learning about floristic diversity and plant communities.

Hike, look, and learn.

Class involves detailed study of floral structure and an introduction to major plant groups and communities.
