**February Meeting:** Wednesday, February 7<sup>th</sup> 7:00pm, Tony Frates, Conservation Co-chair of UNPS will give a presentation titled "Saving Utah's Native Plants: rare, medium rare, and the rarely rare." Tony has spent countless hours fighting on behalf of Utah's most endangered plant species, particularly several in Washington County and the Uintah Basin.
